
Dear Parents of 6-12 Students,

LCCS has been committed to keeping students in the building during these difficult times. We feel that in person instruction is the best way for students to learn, and we are committed to providing that avenue as long as we are able. However, this marking period, the students were not given that luxury of in person instruction for an extended amount of time due to the mandated closure from the State. The 4-5 weeks that students (grades 9-12) were in virtual learning were challenging. Issues with connectivity were frequent, motivation was understandably low for some, technology problems arose commonly, and the list goes on. The students (and staff) were faced with challenges that made the learning experience not as "whole" as years past, which ultimately reduced the learning opportunities for students.

With that being said, we are adjusting how exams are administered for this marking period only. Traditionally, students take a cumulative exam after each marking period. **The exam(s) for this marking period will be optional for students.** It is not mandatory as they have been in previous marking periods/semesters. Students will have until the end of the school day on Wednesday (January 13th) to determine if they want to take exams in their respective courses. Students that do want to take the exam can inform their teacher(s). "Exam Week" is January 18th-January 22nd, however a more detailed schedule will be released at the end of this week for those interested in taking their exam(s). *Students enrolled in classes outside of the district (career center, online, etc.) may still be required to take exams. That will be determined by the teacher of those courses.*
